


In Loving Memory



Archpriest Boniface Black

November 21, 1931 – August 7, 2016

The Archpriest Boniface H. Black, 84, of Souderton, PA died Sunday, August 7, 2016. He was the husband of Khouriye Joyce Black, his wife of 56 years.

Born November 21, 1931 in Quincy, IL, he was a son of the late Orin Russell and Mary Louise (Staley) Black.

Father Boniface served Lutheran Churches in Iowa and Pennsylvania before entering Eastern Orthodoxy. He was Pastor of Saint Philip Antiochian Orthodox Church in Souderton, PA from 1978 until 2009 when he became Pastor of Saint Andrew Antiochian Orthodox Church in Lewes. DE.

He was active in mission work for the Mid-Atlantic Antiochian Orthodox Christian Diocese, having helped start seven congregations in Pennsylvania, Virginia, Delaware, and Maryland. Under his guidance over the years, seven men were ordained into the Orthodox priesthood. In addition, Father Boniface was a treasured mentor to many.



Father Boniface is survived by two children, Jonathan Black (Mary Lynne), of Perkiomenville, PA, and Anna Mary Vogt (Jon) of Yorktown, VA: his brother, Paul William Black, M.D. (Rebecca), of Sarasota, FL; and six grandchildren, Christopher (Sarah), Sarah, and Emily Vogt, Marissa and Hannah Kemperman, and Elena Black.
