- Election of new Audit Committee for 2022.

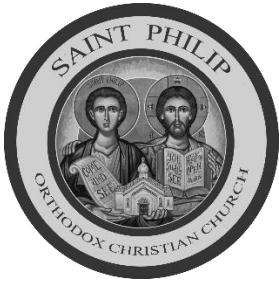
In addition, a cemetery update and St. Justin Academy report will be presented.
