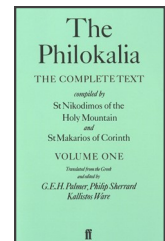

Apr 26: St John Cassian, On the Holy Fathers of Sketis
May 17: St Mark the Ascetic, On the Spiritual Law
Jun 7: St Mark the Ascetic, On No Righteousness by Works



The Philokalia, an anthology on prayer and life in Christ, is one of the most important books on Christian spiritual life. A multi-volume text from Mt Athos in the late 1700s, it contains monumental spiritual writings from the fourth to the fifteenth century. This reading group will study the **first volume of the *Philokalia***.
